

Project #3: Firefox, Bookmarks, and Plug-ins

For your third assignment, you are to:

Download/Install Firefox (If you currently have Firefox, this step is not necessary) **OR** you may work with your existing browser to complete the following steps.



1. **Add three** bookmarks to Firefox or add 3 bookmarks to your existing browser
2. **Install a "plug-in"** into Firefox or an add-on into your existing browser
3. Upload the following files to our course site:
 - Your Firefox bookmarks file or your browser bookmark file. Remember you may add bookmarks to your current browser. Call your file, bookmarksLastName.html
 - A snapshot of your list of **Firefox plugins** or your browser add-ons. Remember you may add plugins or add-ons to your current browser. Call this file pluginsLastName.jpg

Upload these two files to the DropBox in Live. Name your files bookmarks.html and plugins.doc.

Step-by-Step Guide

Exporting Your Bookmarks File

1. Open Firefox. From the Bookmarks menu, select Show All Bookmarks...
2. When the Library or Bookmarks Manager window opens, pull down the Import and Backup menu and select Export HTML.
3. When the Export Bookmark File dialog appears, navigate to where you want the bookmarks file saved, then click the Save button.
4. Close the Library or Bookmarks Manager window.

Creating a Snapshot/Screenshot of your List of Firefox Plugins

1. Use the Topic 3 page in Unit 3 to learn about Firefox Add-ons and how to add them.
2. Open Firefox. From the Tools menu, select Add-ons and then **click Plugins**. (Be sure the plugins are visible before you continue.)
3. If using a Macintosh, hold down the Apple key, the Control key, and the Shift key with one hand. As you hold these three keys down, use the other hand to tap the 3 key quickly. This will take a screenshot of the entire screen and places it in the clipboard.
(On a dual machine, it is Ctrl - F14.)

4. If using Windows, press the Print Screen key (sometimes abbreviated to something such as PrtSc). This will take a screenshot of the entire screen and places it in the clipboard.
5. Open Microsoft Word and create a new document.
6. Select Paste from the Edit menu.
7. Select Save from the File menu.
8. When the Save dialog appears, change the filename to plugins.doc, then navigate to where you want to save the file (such as in your Documents folder or on the Desktop) and click Save

Uploading Your bookmarks file and plugins file

1. Point your browser to <https://Live.wilkes.edu> and log in and open up our ED 526 course
2. Click on Dropbox in the Course Menu
3. Click on Project 3
4. When the Project 3 page appears, scroll down until you locate the Add a File button and click it.
5. When the Submit a File dialog appears, click on the My Computer icon and then click on browse. This will bring up a file dialog allowing you to specify your files.
6. When the Content Browser dialog appears, click the Browse button. When the File Upload dialog appears, navigate to where your bookmarks.html file is stored and select it. Then click Open.
7. Repeat the step above for your plugins file.
8. After selecting your two files, Upload.
9. Now you will be taken back to the Project 3 page. Click the Submit/Save button at the end of the project page to complete the submission process.
10. You will be asked to confirm the submission. Click OK.
11. You will then get a confirmation message that the files were uploaded. Click OK.
