

Project #4: Internet Searching and Copyright

For your next assignment, you are to design an age-appropriate search exercise for your students. You will need to use your recently learned search skills to find and provide your students with 4 or 5 age appropriate sites about Copyright. They will use the sites provided to answer questions in the exercise you create.



The student exercise will be comprised of 20 comprehensive questions. The answers should NOT be single words. Teaching students about searching successfully within sites may be a helpful precursor to this quiz. Answers should require **your students** to **read the material provided in the listed sites**. For this reason, make sure the readability of each site **matches that of your students**. You will need to provide an answer sheet. Specify which site was used for each question. At the end of the answer sheet, list the sites you used in APA format.

This project may have to be adapted to accommodate a wide variety of learning abilities. Contact the instructor if the instructions above do not meet the needs of your students.

If any of the sites you recommend have questions, do not use those. Make your own.

1. 20 **grade and age appropriate questions** about Copyright
 - Teachers of early education and primary age students will not be expected to use all 20 questions with their students.
 - A series of 20 must be submitted to complete the requirements of this assignment.
2. Answer sheet: Answer sheets will be in the following format.
 - 1Q - Type the **question** as it would appear on a student quiz
 - 1A - Type the **answer** that will be accepted for this age group
 - 1URL - Give the exact **URL** and be sure it is **an active hyperlink**
3. APA list of sites used.
 - Be sure your APA formatting is correct.
 - Points will be lost for incorrect formatting.

The 3 items above may be included in one multiple page word processing document.
