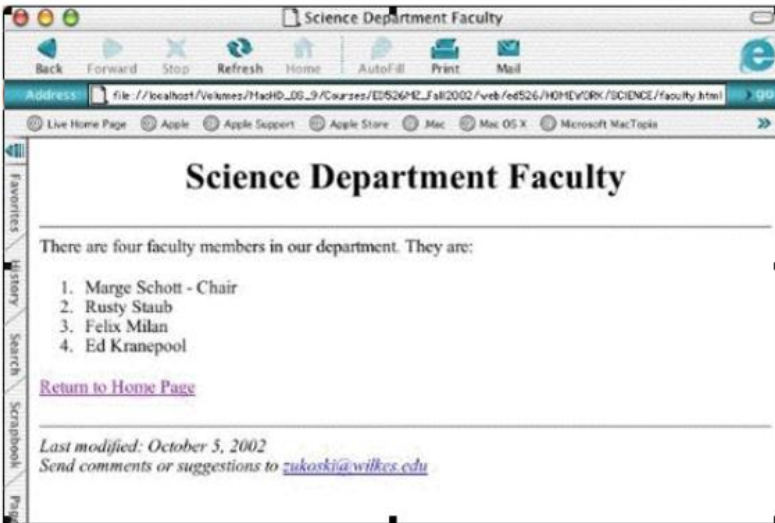


Project #9: Basic Web Development

For your ninth assignment, you are to a simple two-page website.

For your ninth assignment, you are to re-create a simple two-page website using SeaMonkey, Notepad++, or another HTML creator/editor. This assignment will use basic HTML elements such as headings, paragraph/line breaks, images, centering, footers, bulleted lists, and numeric lists. These are skills which you will apply later when designing and creating your final website project. Here is what the two pages should look like:





Create a folder called Science. The first page should be called index.html. The second page should be called faculty.html. (Creating multiple web pages is a skill you will use in your final web site project.)

The Faculty link on the index.html page should be linked to the page faculty.html. The Return link on the faculty.html page should be linked to the index.html page. (Linking web pages and returning links to the home page are skills which will be used in your final web site project.)

You'll need the microscope picture. Right click and save this picture in your Science folder as microscope. Here it is:



When your mini-website is complete, check the Science folder to make certain it contains the 3 files (index.html, faculty.html, and microscope.gif) that make up this website. Zip the Science folder and Submit as an attachment called "Project9lastname.zip".
