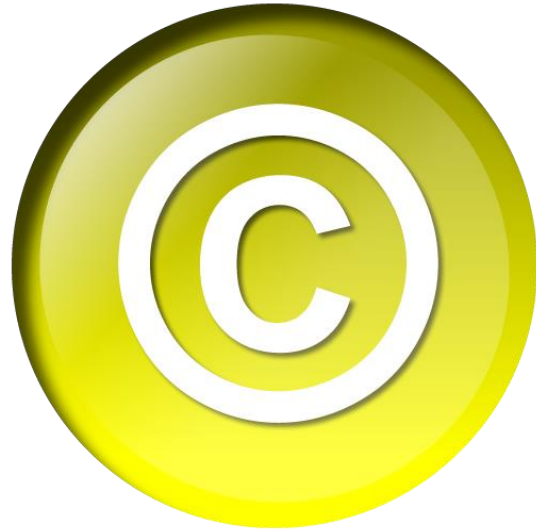


Unit 4 Assignment: Copyright Resource
