

Project #3: Flipped Classroom Paper

Overview

For your Unit 3 assignment, submit to your instructor a 1-2 page paper that describes what you found out about flipping the classroom from your research and the videos. Also include, in your own words, what your flipped classroom would look like, and what tools for flipping you found. Make sure your paper includes your answers to these 2 questions:

1. What will my students know or be able to do after watching this video that I create?
2. How will I be able to tell that they know or can do the thing I teach them?

Anything you teach in your class by standing in front of the students and presenting is fair game for flipping.

The 1-2 page paper you just handed in for Unit 3 is the first part of this “Flipping” assignment that will culminate in Unit 12 where you will actually create and submit a short 3-5 minute video or screencast that you can use in your flipped classroom.
